



CHILDREN'S PROGRAMS -- FALL 2010 SCHEDULE

Term begins the week of 9/13 and runs through 11/20/2010

The Alliance's children's program encompasses four components:

- **Smart Steps to French®** – these classes are intended for Anglophone children who do not have extensive prior knowledge of French.
- **Keeping Up Your French** – these classes are intended for children, aged 11-13, who have previously attended French immersion programs and who wish to maintain their French.
- **Private tutoring or small-group classes** for native-French speakers. Tutoring or specialty classes for native-speaking French students can be arranged through our office, on a case-by-case basis.
- **Private tutoring or specialty small-group classes** – for students wishing to study toward specific goals, whether extra help with their high-school French class, or guidance for passing a DELF or DALF exam. These types of classes can also be arranged through our office on a tutoring basis.

Description: A class for parents and children with nursery rhymes and music, but also, with story and Flash cards games to begin learning words and numbers all in French. An adult must accompany the child. All levels welcome. Meets in the Alliance Kamm House or FUMC.

Fee: \$75. As with all Alliance classes, annual student (\$20) or family membership (\$48) is required.

Description: Children become attuned to the French language in a fun, educational and age appropriate environment through cultural and linguistic immersion. Following the standard Alliance Française curriculum "Smart Steps To French," each session will explore different themes and linguistic skills, with corresponding vocabulary. Songs, games, "Flash cards" and other materials help children discover the pleasure of speaking as well as hearing and understanding a new language. They learn and memorize words, recognize, understand and build little sentences. Most of instructions are given in French.

Fee: \$165. As with all Alliance classes, annual student (\$20) or family membership (\$48) is required; books will be charged separately.

Description: This class is designated specifically for children who have previously attended classes, typically through grade 5, in a French immersion program. This is an after-school class for fluent French-speaking children of middle-school age seeking an extra-curricular, after-school opportunity to use the language in themed contexts such as games, photography, cuisine, film and more, and coordinated by native-fluent instructors.

Fee: \$165. As with all Alliance classes, annual student (\$20) or family membership (\$48) is required. Texts will be determined by group and will be charged separately.

Private Tutoring or Small-Group Class

- **Private tutoring or small-group classes** for native-French speakers. Tutoring or specialty classes for native-speaking French students can be arranged through our office, on a case-by-case basis.
- **Private tutoring or specialty small-group classes** – for students wishing to study toward specific goals, whether extra help with their high-school French class, or guidance for passing a DELF or DALF exam. These types of classes can also be arranged through our office on a tutoring basis.

Private lessons for children are \$40/hour for one-on-one instruction, \$22 per hour / per student for 2-person instruction (2 students, one instructor), \$15 per hours / per student for 3-on-1, and \$13 per student/per hour for 4 on 1.

As with all Alliance classes, annual student (\$20) or family membership (\$48) is required; books will be charged separately.

Policies for Children’s Programs:

- Minimum enrollment to hold a small-group class is 5 students.
- Free make-ups for children’s classes are not provided.

Book prices are as follows. *Each book lasts for 4-5 terms.*

- \$40 per set for Tatou le Matou (retail is \$49); includes student text and workbook.
- \$42 per set for Alex/Zoe (retail is \$52); includes student text, workbook and CD.
- \$32 per set for Et Toi (retail is \$42); includes student text and workbook.
